“Clean Waterways” is a series of volunteer cleanup events in the Anacostia River watershed.

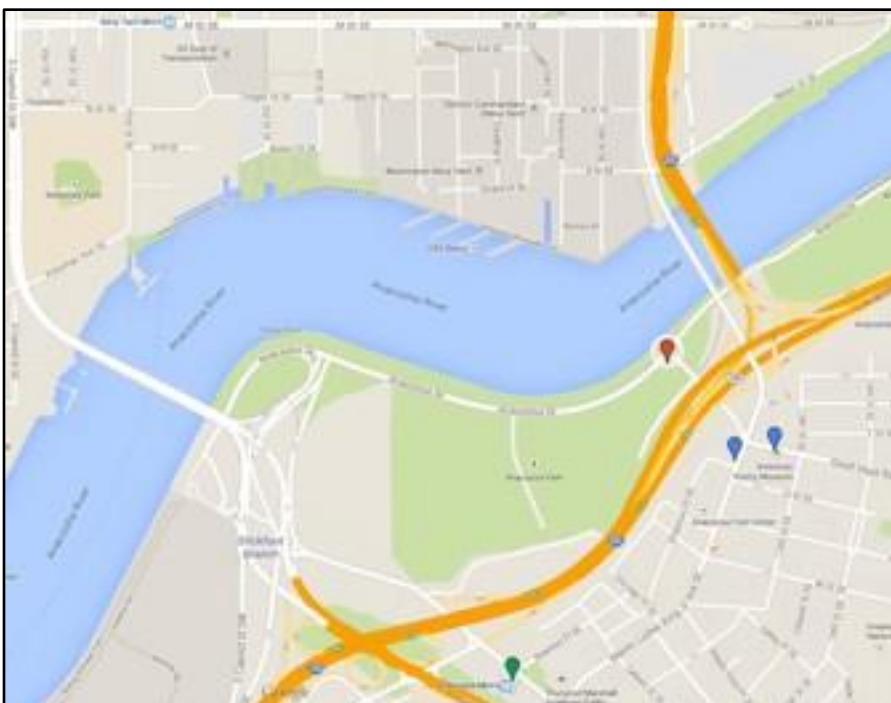
Rain or Shine. All supplies & water provided.
